### Business Re-Engineering (20 hours)

- Provides insight on the state of nanotechnology from an industry perspective.
- Highlights fundamental applications, environmental issues, and how to finance and run a successful nanotech venture.
- This intensive 2 1/2 day program consists of classroom style lectures, group discussions and development of a mini-business proposal.

### Train the Trainer (30 hours)

- Features a series of technical workshops on state-of-the-art advanced manufacturing techniques, including nanocharacterization, nanofabrication, and the commercial applications for nanobiotechnology, thin films and carbon nanotubes.
- This 4-day intensive program consists of classroom style lectures, group discussions, a tour of a nanomanufacturing site, and a workshop to develop a mini-proposal.
